I think it helps if you try and enter an environment where you think you can learn a lot. And whether that's inside an organization, it doesn't have to be a company, it can be some other organization, or around people that you particularly admire that you can learn a lot from. And I think that just helps expand one's horizons and also gives the individual a sense of what excellence is really like. If you pick the right setting or the right set of individuals, and done right, it's a transformative set of experiences, and massively expands your horizons, and the sense that you have of all the wonderful array of opportunities that lie in front of you.
